Innovation In Housing

OBJECTIVES

Address the disparity in life expectancy and prevalence of chronic conditions across CTMUHB caused by poorly insulated and inefficient housing.

This objective will be achieved through a collaborative approach involving multiple stakeholders.

SOLUTIONS

This project will identify the homes in Cwm Taf Morgannwg that can most benefit, through the linkage of housing and health data, and using this insight to maximise applications to ECO4 and LA Flex schemes in order to retrofit properties with housing efficiency improvements, to improve housing Energy Performance Certificates (EPC) and in turn improve equity in health.

BENEFITS

Benefits One

Scope and establish data linkage processes to link housing, energy efficiency and health/healthcare data at an individual and household level.

Benefits Two

Develop referral pathways for EPC assessment and access to home improvement grants.

Benefits Three

Undertake epidemiological and health economic analysis to identify specific links between housing and health and those with the greatest need.

Benefits Four

Describing potential sustainable approaches for stakeholders by defining the flow of eligible homes.
