OBJECTIVES

As part of the Governments response to the Covid-19 Global Pandemic, the NHS undertook a vaccination programme with the aim of vaccinating the UK population against the virus. The scale and complexity of the programme was unprecedented and created an enormous challenge for Health Boards across the UK, which needed to implement an effective operation at speed. Benefits One

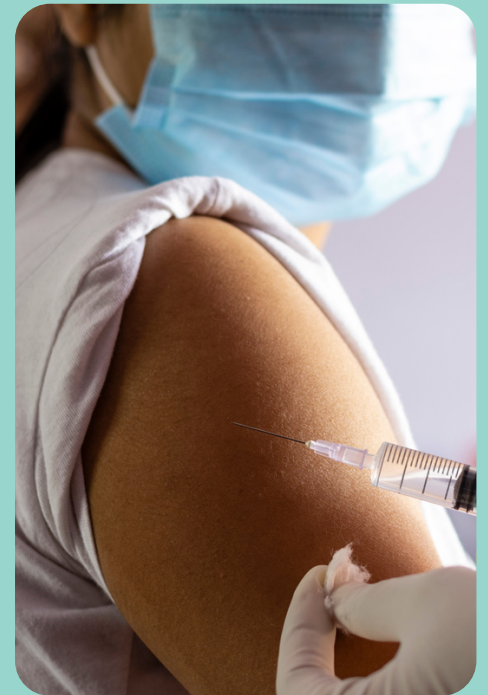
This brought clarity, simplified the task and provided a greater degree of accountability for stakeholders.
