2. HIGHLIGHT REPORT

ALERT / ESCALATE	Demand and stress levels in primary care are extremely high. There is a concern that GPs are leaving wherever they can find the opportunity, due to the nature of the workload. There is a need for more supportive media information regarding the pressures in primary care.
ADVISE	CAG discussed the results of the wellbeing survey. Some aspects were positive but there is a worrying level of stress and fatigue. Only 20% of the workforce responded. There was a concern that the 80% who did not may be those with greater wellbeing needs. The wellbeing team outlined the range of resources available and the need to share these resources widely.

INFORM	Work is ongoing to improve engagement in the Clinical Advisory Group, which has fallen recently.
