CTM: Our Health Our Future

Natasha Weeks, Head of Involvement and Engagement presented an overview of the development of the engagement process for CTMUHB's organisation strategy CTM: Our Health Our Future.

NHS Wales App

Claire Nelson informed members that Digital Health and Care Wales were developing an NHS Wales 'app' around health and social care, which worked from smart phones/devices and were looking for patients and the public living and working in Wales to help co-design and co-produce it. A link to the 'app' will be shared with members encouraging members to help with the 'apps' development.

New Patient Feedback System

Members were advised that the HB was looking to launch a new patient feedback system called 'Civica' from January 2022. A QR code will be available on the CTMUHB webpage and on posters displayed within the HB sites in order for the public to be put through to a short survey to comment on their experience at CTMUHB hospitals. Following this they will receive a request to complete a more detailed survey if they have the time. Work is currently ongoing with the Control of Infection team to consider ways forward for completing surveys for those unable to use the electronic format but the HB was also looking to add a link to the system on the HB Ipads.
