Patient Safety & Experience Highlight Report Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board **Reporting Period June-August 2021**







Introduction

This Patient Safety and Experience Highlight Report provides an 'at a glance' update on the current patient safety and experience landscape within the Welsh Ambulance Services NHS Trust and Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board area. It specifically focusses upon the following key areas:

Summary

We can see from the data presented, that of the 7,908 handover presentations at Emergency departments within Cwm Taf Morgannwg during this quarter (June-August), 3,440 were outside of the 15 minute notification to handover target time.

In addition to this, 1,100 patients waited between 1 hour and 10 hours to handover care to Emergency department staff.

During this quarter (June-August), 5,450 patients awaited a primary response in the community between 1 and 32 hours. From the data contained within slide 8, it can be seen that 4,730 of these patients were in the Amber 1/2 category. These categories include, chest pain, stroke, dyspnoea, overdose, abdominal pain, allergic reactions, unconsciousness (and fainting). Significantly, the chest pain and stroke patients (if confirmed +ve) would by definition have missed the opportunity for clinical intervention such as PPCI and Thrombolysis.

88 Green 2 & 3 patients waited more than 4 hrs for a response.

17 red calls waited outside of agreed timeframes, however these are likely to be amber calls that have escaled, further investigation is required.




Handover delays > 60 mins Average Patient Final Handover- June

Average Patient Final Handover Time by Week Year




Handover delays > 60 mins Average Patient Final Handover- July

Average Patient Final Handover Time by Week Year





Average Patient Final Handover Time by Week Year



Joint Investigation Framework – Appendix b

Joint Investigation Framework – Appendix b (Source: SCIF)

The Joint Investigation Framework includes all Health Boards and Trusts in Wales, and relates to patient safety incidents escalated by The Welsh Ambulance Services NHS Trust (WAST) that have been considered at the Serious Case Incident Forum (SCIF) and where the primary causal factor relates to or as a consequence of Health Board hospital handover delays.

During the period <u>June - August 2021</u> there was three incident that was reviewed at the SCIF which met the criteria for the appendix b framework.

- 59022 The Trust received a call on 8th April 2021 at 21:23hrs for a 70 year old male who was reported as having low blood pressure and fainted to the floor. The call was prioritised Amber2. There were a number of Amber1&2 calls polling at that time. A second call was received at 00:05hrs on 9th April 2021 prioritised Amber1 and a third call at 01:14hrs prioritised Red. The first resource arrived on scene at 01:31hrs and conveyed the patient to hospital.
- 60313 The Trust received a call on 12th June 2021 at 17:23hrs for a 98 year old female reported as lying on the floor with a head injury. The call was prioritised Amber2 but there were no available resources at that time. A second call was received at 03:44hrs on the 13th June 2021, prioritised Amber1. It was reported that the patient was not having difficulty in breathing. A third call was received at 04:35hrs notifying that the patient had passed away and there was a DNACPR in place. ROLE was implemented at scene.
- 60654 / 60926 The Trust received a call on 28th June 2021 at 10:52hrs for a 74 year old female patient who required a transfer to UHCW following a CT scan which identified a brain bleed. The patient was vomiting and on blood thinners. The call was prioritised Amber2 but there were no suitable resources available to allocate. At 12:31hrs the site manager rang up requesting an ETA but it was noted that there were 33 Amber1 calls ahead of this one. At 12:35hrs the CSD upgraded the call to Amber1 and at 21:16hrs further escalated the call to Red. A resource arrived on scene at 21:21hrs and conveyed the patient to UHWC.

Please note that 60654 and 60926 were sent on separate Appendix b's but it was identified during audit that these Datix numbers related to the same incident.





During the period June - August there were a total of 28 concerns received for the Cwm Taf Morgannwg Health Board area.

Of the 28 concerns received, 17 related to timeliness, with some patients having waited up to 13 hrs for an Ambulance response.

*The underlying cause of the Ambulance delay could be attributed to a number of factors, including Hospital Handover Delays. Further investigation is required to identify the overarching cause.
