CTM UHB COVID-19 Vaccination Update

BOOSTER UPDATE

This week our vaccination teams have administered nearly 6000 boosters, taking the total number of boosters given to date to **265,512**. That figure is 78% of the eligible population – you are eligible if you are aged 16 + and received your 2nd dose of COVID-19 vaccine at least 13 weeks ago. Some under 18s are also eligible due to underlying health conditions or employment status.

The table below is a breakdown of the number of boosters given by age and/or by priority group. It shows the total number of vaccines given and the percentage of people in that group who have received their booster jab.

Walk in vaccine and booster jabs

You can still walk in for your vaccine this month at all of our five community vaccination centres.

Walk-in times for week commencing 17th January, 2022

- **9.30am – 6.00PM (Monday – Friday)**
- **9.30am – 4.30pm Saturday 22nd & Sunday 23rd January**

Who can walk in?

- You can walk in for your vaccine as follows:
 - 1st dose – anyone 12 years and over
 - 2nd dose – anyone 12 years and over (see website on intervals after 1st dose)
 - 3rd dose – those 12+ who are severely immunosuppressed (see website)
 - Boosters – those 18 and over who had their 2nd dose 13 weeks ago
- 1st, 2nd, (3rd immunosuppressed) and booster jabs.

Please note there is further guidance on the website on the guidance of the time period you need to wait if you have had a COVID 19 infection.

Walk-in flu vaccine for children

Our vaccination teams are also holding a flu vaccine clinic for children in all our CVCs on **Saturday 22nd and Sunday 23rd January - 9.30am-4.00pm**

If your child missed the flu vaccine in school or at the GP practice, **it's not too late**. No appointment needed – just pop along.

The nasal spray provides a quick and painless way to protect your child from flu and is available free for the following children:

- All children in primary school
- All children in secondary school years 7 to 11
- All children who are aged two or three on 31 August 2021

Vaccine Progress

The total number of vaccines administered across all three local authorities is **983,454** (Figures correct Mon Jan 17 2022). Our uptake of first dose (everyone received at least one dose) is **362,609** – 88%; second dose (everyone received at least 2 doses) is **347,361** – 96%%; third doses is **7,972** - 93% and boosters **265,512** - 78%.

Vaccinations for Children and Young People.

January appointments have been sent out to 12-15 years old for their second dose. If you have a child who still needs a first dose you can attend one of our walk in sessions.

New JCVI vaccination advice for children and young people.

Children aged 5-11, who are in a clinical risk group or who are a household contact of someone who is immunosuppressed, will be offered a primary course of vaccination. Appointments will be on their way very shortly.

Boosters

As announced by the JCVI in December 2021, booster vaccinations should be offered to persons aged 16-17 years; those who are in a clinical risk group aged 12-15 years or are a household contact of someone who is immunosuppressed or 12-15 years who are themselves severely immunocompromised and who have had a third primary dose.

Appointments have been made for those eligible and should be with you this week, with the majority of the appointments the weekend of the 22nd/23rd January. Watch out for a text reminder as well.

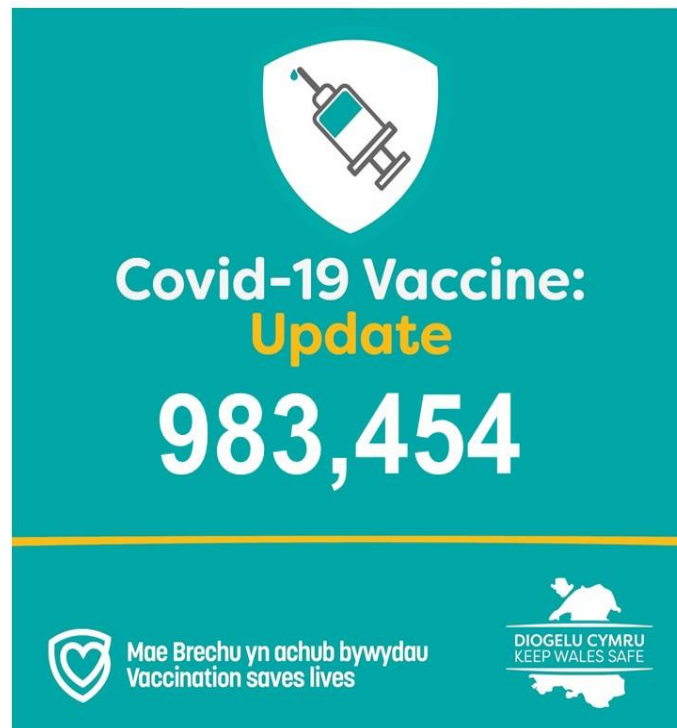
Vaccination Advice Line
