

Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTHB_265_17

You asked:

Please could you answer the questions below about your health board's waiting times specifically relating to suspected Parkinson's and Parkinson's reviews:

- 1. What is the current wait time from referral to first appointment, where Parkinson's is suspected, for a person to see a specialist with expertise in Parkinson's?**

Waiting times are approx 30 weeks for routine patients but patients deemed urgent can be seen earlier based on Clinical review of the GP letter.

- 2. When a diagnosis of Parkinson's has been made, at what intervals are people with Parkinson's currently receiving a review of their Parkinson's with a specialist with expertise in Parkinson's?**

Follow up is based on the patient condition and can range from 6 weeks to 3 months or even up to 6 months.
