You asked:

I should be grateful if you would provide answers to the following questions under the Freedom of Information Act in relation to the number of patients waiting for a review outpatient appointment.

- 1. In total, how many patients are waiting for a review outpatient appointment as of 31 May 2017 in your Health Board?
- 2. How many patients waiting (as of 31 May 2017) for review outpatient appointments are overdue the review date specified by the requesting clinician (due date) by:
 - a) More than 6 weeks
 - b) More than 6 months
 - c) More than 12 months
 - d) More than 25% overdue the requesting clinicians review interval
 - e) More than 50% overdue the requesting clinicians review interval

Our response:

- 1. As of the 31st May 2017 there are 81,963 patients awaiting a review outpatient appointment.
- 2. Please see the breakdown requested below:

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More than 6 weeks = 17,569
More than 6 months = 9,195
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More than 12 months = 4,602

More than 25% overdue the requesting clinicians review interval = 19,699 More than 50% overdue the requesting clinicians review interval = 16,204
