## Our response:

I can confirm that the Health Board does not centrally record the detailed information requested. Whilst the number of referrals to the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS) and Adult Mental Health Service may be recorded, this would not include a definitive diagnosis. The detail you require would be recorded within an individual patient's health record as part of their ongoing care. To provide you with this information, would require a manual trawl and significantly exceed the 18 hours time and £450 cost limit set out within Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act.
