You asked:

- 1 - Does your administration have an impact assessment or plan/strategy regarding the continuation of all functions of your administration after the March 2019 deadline for leaving the European Union?
- 2 - In addition to points 1, Does your administration have any plans to inform the public in your administrative area of decisions taken in such a situation?
- 3 - Does your administration have a body or committee tasked with mitigation of impacts in regards to Brexit?
- 4 - Does your administration plan to take legal action alongside other administration against the UK Government's policies regarding their direction of Brexit or any other related service-delivery/austerity policy?

Our response:

Cwm Taf University Health Board does not have specific plans or committees related to Brexit. However, we are part of the work coordinated by the Welsh NHS Confederation which is a membership body representing all the organisations making up the NHS in Wales: seven Local Health Boards and three NHS Trusts.
