You asked:

1. The monies clawed back from NHS primary care dental contracts due to underperformance for the year 2017/2018

The Health Board will be recovering £290,145 from primary care dental contracts due to underperformance for the financial year 2017/18. (However this total includes an amount for one practice which has not yet been agreed by the Provider so this current figure may reduce).

2. The monies handed back from NHS primary care dental contracts for the year 2017/2018

No monies were handed back in 2017/18.

3. The number of practices facing claw back from NHS primary care dental contracts due to underperformance for the year 2017/2018

There were 10 practices that under performed in 2017/18 and had to repay funding to the Health Board.

4. The number of practices handing back NHS primary care dental contracts for the year 2017/2018
