

## Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTHB\_285\_18

### You asked:

I'm emailing to ask under the Freedom of Information Act for the latest figures you have available on the ratio of nurses to patients in mental health wards in Cwm Taf.

### Our response:

Across the Mental Health Directorate within Cwm Taf, each Ward has been individually assessed and Ward managers across the Directorate have been utilising the Staff Acuity tool as developed by Public Health Wales to measure activity across mental health wards to monitor the demands across the wards.

Please find below, as requested, a breakdown of the current ratio of nurses to patients in the Mental Health Wards, Cwm Taf. The ratios have been calculated using the number of beds per wards with the total number of qualified and unqualified nursing establishments.
