1. How much money was spent on PPE for the health board during 2020

The Health Board uses a standard coding system to report expenditure. PPE can include items which have multiple uses and be reported to multiple codes. To answer your question we have used the standard reporting category of 'Protective Clothing', you refer to expenditure incurred during 2020. The figures have been collated using expenditure reported from January 2020 through to August 2020. It is also important to note that PPE was received by the Health Board from a national procurement process which was not charged to the Health Board but centrally funded by Welsh Government, and hence the expenditure for these free of charge supplies are not included in the figures shown below.
