2. What's the timeline for local vaccine centres in RCT?

Opened on January 4th.

3. Will Cwm Taf Morgannwg be providing the second course injection in line with the manufacturer's instructions? If not why not and what will be the timescales used?

We are following nation JCVI guidance in line with national policy.

4. When and how will elderly and or house bound residents be getting their vaccine?

Elderly over 80s are being vaccinated from this week by GPs including housebound. Following first dose completion teams will move in line with priority groups as outlined by Welsh Government.

5. As pharmacists have been manning their stations since the start of the Covid-19 pandemic will they be getting vaccinated as a matter of urgency so that they can continue to provide the services the population rely on?

Pharmacists are included as front line staff and appointments have and continue to be made available.
