

Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_320_21

You asked:

I am writing in regards to a military exercise on the 25th and 26th February 2016.

In your previous information request you advised you received an email, advising that you had prior notification of the exercise.

How many times has the Royal Glamorgan hospital received notification of military exercises?

Under section 21 of the Act, Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board is not required to provide information in response to a request if it is already reasonably accessible to you. The information you requested is available within the [Disclosure Log](#) on the [Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board](#) web site. For ease of access, I have attached a link directly to the information here. (Reference [CTHB 370 18](#)).

To confirm this response is still valid. In addition to this, there are no requirements to keep details of notifications of exercises in the area surrounding the Royal Glamorgan Hospital or other Health Board sites.

Is this normal practice for the Royal Glamorgan hospital to receive notification for military exercises?

The Military will usually request permission to use the landing site unless it is a covert operation or an emergency. As stated, these details are not required to be formally recorded.
