You asked:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information from the Health Board.

1. At what centres/locations in Wales are cerebral palsy children and adolescents (up to age of 18 years) treated with botulinum toxin for spasticity?
 - a. If patients are referred to centres in England for botulinum toxin treatment please include these centres as well.
2. How many unique cerebral palsy children/adolescents (up to age of 18 years) were treated with botulinum toxin for spasticity at each centre named in the response to question 1 in 2019 and 2020?
 - a. If these data are unavailable how many unique cerebral palsy children/adolescents (up to age of 18 years) were seen for spasticity at each centre named in the response to question 1 in 2019 and 2020?
 - i. If unique data are or are not available please also provide the number of episodes or attendances.
