

Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_492_21

You asked:

For your Health Board, what is the current waiting time for an autism assessment for children and young people?

Our response:

There is a considerable demand for the Neurodevelopmental Service, with waiting times currently around 18-24 months. Children/young people referred for assessment of Autism Spectrum Disorder or Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder are all placed on a 'routine' waiting list for assessment and are treated in turn. An appointment is offered with the clinician who is most appropriate to assess based on age and the reason for referral.
