Please note, Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board was established on 1 April 2019 and covers 3 locality areas:

- Merthyr and Cynon Locality – Prince Charles Hospital (PCH).
- Rhondda and Taf Ely Locality – Royal Glamorgan Hospital (RGH).
- Bridgend Locality – Princess of Wales Hospital (POW).

The tongue-tie division for the Merthyr and Cynon Locality and Rhondda and Taf Ely Locality is provided at PCH.

For the Bridgend locality (Princess of Wales Hospital), there is a service level agreement with Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (OMFS) Swansea Bay University Health Board.

Personal Information is held by Data Controllers on the basis of the exercise of functions identified in the formal notification to the Information Commissioner. Any processing of that personal information outside of those functions may be unlawful. Furthermore the General Data Protection regulation and Data Protection Act 2018 makes provision for a data subject to exercise a right to prevent processing in particular circumstances. The data subject shall have the right to object, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her which is based on point (e) or (f) of Article 6(1), including profiling based on those provisions where personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes.
