The Health Board holds quarterly decontamination meetings. The last meeting was held on the 12th October 2021. Meetings arranged for the 10th January 2022 and 29th March 2022 were cancelled due to other clinical priorities and the number of apologies received for the meetings.

4. Which other roles also attend the Decontamination Risk Assessment Group meeting?

The membership for the decontamination committee is - Deputy Lead IPC Nurse/operational lead for decontamination, Lead IPC Nurse, IPC Doctor/Microbiologist, Sterile Services Department Manager, Authorised Persons for Decontamination (APDs), Decontamination Engineer Shared Services, Integrated Locality Group representation from service users and Deputy

Heads of Nursing (endoscopy, theatres, maternity services, cardiology, radiology, dental, ears nose and throat departments, urology), Estates colleagues, Health and Safety Officer, Procurement.
