12. Do you have any subcontracting arrangements for Cataract Surgery with the independent sector within this financial year, if so please provide details including volumes?

There are currently arrangements in place with Spire & Nuffield healthcare for outsourcing of cataracts surgery – this financial year, 196 procedures have been carried out by them so far.

The Health Board has also sent 48 cases to I Care Health Group Ltd.
