

Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_359_22

You asked:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information:

- 1. What were your organisational compliance rates for statutory and mandatory training (separately) in the following years: 2018,2019,2020,2021 and year to date?**

Compliance for CTMUHB is provided in the table below:

It is not possible to provide compliance for a particular period, however, we are able to provide compliance rates at a particular date period.

Level 1 is the minimum training that staff have to complete. However, some staff require a higher level of training and this has also been mandated within CTMUHB. "All Levels of Training" also include the level 1 compliance.

- 2. What was your organisational spend on e-learning in the following years: 2018,2019,2020,2021 and year to date.**

We are unable to provide this information as we do not budget for this.

- 3. What percentage of your statutory and mandatory training was delivered via e-learning in the following years: 2018,2019,2020,2021 and year to date.**

In general terms, e-learning has markedly increased since 2021, with a growing utility of virtual and e-learning being used across the organisation.
