- Because OD is frequently used as a presenting complaint along with other text. We have excluded any presenting complaint that contained the following text - body, today ,episode ,Abod ,stood ,adema ,sodium ,food ,wood and blood these all contain OD in the word.
- We have also included any data in the Nature of incident field = 'OVERDOSE/POISONING (INGESTION)'
- We have also included all patient with an ICD10 code with relates to overdose.
- We cannot guarantee a patient has received treatment the data is based on condition on arrival at the ED and possible admission diagnosis codes.
- Accidental and deliberate overdoses have been included.
- The Princes of Wales Hospital only joined Cwm Taf Morgannwg on 01/04/2023 so we cannot guarantee the accuracy of the data prior to 01/04/2019.

Where numbers are low we have considered that there is the potential for the individuals to be identified from the information provided, when considered with other information that may also be in the public domain. Also, responses under the Freedom of Information Act are made available to the public at large. The data is classed as personal data as defined under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 and its disclosure would be contrary to the data protection principles and constitute as unfair and unlawful processing in regard to Articles 5, 6, and 9 of GDPR. We are therefore withholding this detail under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.

3. How many drug-related deaths have been recorded in your health board in 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023? Please provide a monthly breakdown of each of the years listed (January, February, March, etc).

We can confirm that the Health Board does hold this information. However, to release the specific information by month as requested would mean disclosure of low numbers.

This being the case it is considered that such information should be withheld under Section 41 which sets out an exemption from the right to know where the information requested was provided to the public authority in confidence. The component which is applicable relates to the disclosure of the information would give rise to an actionable breach of confidence. In other words, if the Health Board disclosed the information being sought this could lead to their identification which would be unfair and inappropriate.

A duty of confidentiality does continue after the death of an individual to whom that duty is owed. Where there is a legally enforceable duty of confidentiality owed to a living individual, after death it can be enforced by the deceased's personal representative.
