You asked:

I would like to make a freedom of information request for the following, please:

1. The quantity of single use drinking water bottles purchased by Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board annually, for the past 5 years

605,088.

2. The cost of said purchase

£72,042.60.

3. Details of the supply and disposal chains.

Disposal - Our current disposal contract is with Veolia UK.

All recycling waste is sent out as DMR (Dry Mixed Recycling) with a view to source segregate bottles and cans in April 2024 in line with Welsh Local Government Association (WLGA) targets.

Disposal fees would include all recycled items and not water bottles only in isolation.
