

Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_449_23

You asked:

Can I please get eyes on the criteria that these applications (parking permits) are judged on?

Our response:

The criteria that applications for parking permits are assessed against is as follows:

Either

- Staff MUST have a requirement to travel and work between at least two healthcare/hospital sites during the course of one working day AND return to the original starting site. Travel from one site to another and then home would not qualify for a permit
- This requirement to travel MUST be related to direct patient services and does not include the requirement to attend meetings

OR

- Staff are required during the course of their daily duties to have rapid access to the main acute hospital sites to provide a direct patient service e.g. to support A&E, Children's or maternity services, ITU etc.

To qualify for a parking permit to use Sardis Road Car Park for staff based in Dewi Sant health Park is different to the above and applications are assessed using the following criteria:

- Staff should be based on the Dewi Sant site 5 days a week, applicants working less days will be considered after those working 5 days.
- Staff supporting Clinical Services will be considered firstly with office-based staff considered secondly.
- Peripatetic staff due to the nature of their role will be considered lastly due to the nature of their role, they should not be site based for full days, and should make full use of the parking on the Dewi Sant site.
