You asked:

1. Please can you confirm how many section 28 Prevention of Future death Notices your Health Board Received 1 April 23 -31 December 23. (or as records permit, the cut off date is simply to correspond with the reporting period indicated below so an reasonably adjacent cut off date would suffice)

To be used as a comparator so as per note from BCUHB January Board which appear to run at 2 per calendar month. If this is a regular report to Board on sec 28 notices (or Q&S Committee) and you held a January (or Feb) Board (or Q&S Committee) then that figure would be fine.

Dear HL, if Possible could you show, if any, notices associated with Caswell Clinic Separately excerpt from BCUHB Quality Report to January 2024 Board.

Since April 2023, the Health Board has received 18 Regulation 28 Prevention of Future Death Notices. Both Senior Coroners in the region have raised a number of serious concerns. Our response:

Under section 21 of the Act, Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board is not required to provide information in response to a request if it is already reasonably accessible to you.

As this information is routinely published on the [Courts and Tribunals Judiciary website](#), it is therefore exempt from disclosure under Section 21 (information accessible by other means). As this is an absolute exemption under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, there is no requirement for the Health Board to consider the public interest test.

However, to assist you with your request we can confirm that only one (1) Regulation 28 has been recorded for the dates in question.
