You asked:

Please may you provide details of the following:

1. Confirmation that the Trust/organisation is responsible for the provision of inpatient and or community mental health services in your area?

We can confirm that we are responsible for the provision of inpatient and community mental health services for the area within Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board boundaries. The Criminal Justice and Forensic Team in CTMUHB support individuals within the community and inpatient care that are subject to Forensic Sections and under the Ministry of Justice.

2. Has the Trust/organisation received a copy of the national Mentally Disordered Offenders Victim Protocol and the date received from the Ministry of Justice?

We do not have the National Mentally Disordered Offenders Victim Protocol. This has been requested and we are awaiting receipt of a copy.

3. Define the specific arrangements within your Trust/organisation to meet the requirements set in the national Mentally Disordered Offenders Victim Protocol?

Without sight of the National Mentally Disordered Offenders Victim Policy, we are unable to state whether we meet the requirements of the protocol.

4. Is there a Trust/organisation policy/procedure for enacting the arrangements for Victim work set out in the national Mentally Disordered Offenders Victim Protocol? Please can you provide a copy?

As a Criminal Justice and Forensic Team, we do not have a policy or procedure for enacting the arrangements set out by the protocol.

5. Confirmation of the resources dedicated to Victims (such as a lead post or designated team) to meet the requirements set out in the Mentally Disordered Offenders Victim Protocol? Please describe the model and staffing resource?

We email this service to see if there are any Victim Liaison Officer linked to our cases. As a team we work with perpetrators and not victims. We request Victim Liaison Officers are a part of meetings so that the victim is aware of leave plans etc.
