Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_364_24

You asked:

I am currently collating some information on behalf of Radis Community Care in order to update their national training plan. As part of this process, I need to identify which staff will requires Tier 1 & Tier 2 Oliver McGowan Mandatory training on Learning Disability and Autism.

The information I require is as follows:

1. Local training offer to Providers of Supported living, domiciliary care, and Extra Care within your organisation in relation to mandatory training requirements.
2. Do you provide or support providers to achieve mandatory training?
3. Your quality requirement relating to supporting adults with learning disability and autism?
4. What learning disability training requirement do you have for staff supporting older adults in the community/extra care housing who may have some degree of learning disability but are not commissioned through learning disability commissioning?

Our response:

We can confirm that the Health Board does not hold the information you require.

Oliver McGowan training relates to England. Wales developed their own training, the [Paul Ridd](#) Learning Disability Education and training Programme for NHS Wales Healthcare staff. The first phase of that Programme, the Foundation (Awareness) Level was made mandatory by the [Welsh Government](#) and launched on the 1st April 2022. We as a Health Board then mandated the training shortly after the launch.

As of the 5th July 2024, our compliance figure is currently 85.58% for CTMUHB . There are two other levels of training to the programme, which are still in development, being led by [Heath Education and Improvement Wales](#) (HEIW).
