Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_376_24

You asked:

Please find my context, followed by request below:

The information I am requesting may or may not come under 're-useable data' and so this request for information incorporates the request to re-use this data, in order to achieve the following:

We would like to support the CTMUHB on their quest for long term energy cost cutting, and/or sustainability/net zero targets.

We would do this by looking at the recommissioning, or continued operation/maintenance/servicing of existing CHP units, and/or considering the suitability of solar panels.

There is considerable value in looking at all this as a whole, rather than site by site and provision by provision, and my hope is that you will see the value of such a request.

It is our experience that as CHP units get older, the cost for site visits and maintenance sky-rocket when your contract is with a large corporation rather than a smaller company. Overheads become the main driver for those 'big-boys'. The units are often decommissioned unnecessarily due to rising costs rather than looking to overhaul the unit to give it many more years of life incorporating an Operation and Maintenance provision which will keep costs from escalating unnecessarily.

If solar is something the sites are considering, we would look at utilising the larger sites or undeveloped land for solar space but then link in the smaller sites where solar isn't an option, so that they can take advantage of the energy being generated at those larger sites. In this way increasing the amount of renewable energy being used across the jurisdiction.

2 x 210kWe units are out of contract and currently under negotiation.
1 x 650kWe is under contract until 08-Sep-2028.
