

Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_334_24

You asked:

We are collecting data about recruitment rates on commercially sponsored clinical trials (*primarily Phase II and III*) and would appreciate it if you could share with us a list of the trials that your Institution has participated in the past five (5) years. We are happy to receive this information in any format but, ideally, we would like the information to include:

- Sponsor's name;
- NCT Study Number;
- Confirmation of whether your Institution successfully enrolled patients into the trial (i.e. completed screening and recruited)- (Yes / No); and
- Confirmation of how many patients were successfully enrolled at your Institution (i.e. completed screening and recruited).

The data is classed as personal data as defined under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Act 2018 and its disclosure would be contrary to the data protection principles and constitute as unfair and unlawful processing in regard to Articles 5, 6, and 9 of GDPR. We are therefore withholding this detail under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This exemption is absolute and therefore there is no requirement to apply the public interest test.
