You asked:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information from you.

- 1. How long are people waiting for a dementia diagnosis in Cwm Taf Morgannwg? This should be provided for each of the last three years to the date of your reply, and should be in this format: What proportion of people booked in for a dementia diagnosis appointment are waiting a) 0-10 weeks b)11-20 weeks c)21-30 weeks d)31-40 weeks e)41-50 weeks f)51-60 weeks g)61-70 weeks h)71-80 weeks i)81-90 weeks j) More than 90 weeks.**

We are unable to provide accurate waiting times for the years requested except for April 2024, which is the most up to date waiting times available.

- 2. What percentage of dementia patients had a dementia review once a year in a) the first year b) the first two years c) the first five years after they were diagnosed with dementia.**

We can confirm that the Health Board does not centrally record this information. The information you require would be recorded within an individual patient's health record as part of their ongoing care. To provide you with this information, would require a manual trawl and significantly exceed the 18 hours time and £450 cost limit set out within Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act.
