Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_588_24

You asked:

Please can I request the following statistics from your health board under the Freedom of Information Act.

Data on patients who are waiting to start an Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) or Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) neurodevelopment assessment (children and young people aged 17 years 6 months and under). **As a point of reference I have included an all Wales census snapshot as an attachment.**

- I'd like a census snapshot from 1st of September 2019, 1st of September 2020, 1st of September 2021, 1st of September 2022, 1st of September 2023 + 1st of September 2024 with the following breakdown for each snapshot:**

- Number of patients waiting 0-364 days (0-1 year)**
- Number of patients waiting 365 - 729 days (1-2 years)**
- Number of patients waiting 730 – 1094 days (2-3 years)**
- Number of patients waiting 1095 – 1459 days (3-4 years)**
- Number of patients waiting 1460 days + (4 years+)**
- Total number waiting**

Please find below table relating to waiting times for assessment of Autism Spectrum Disorder and/or Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder within the Neurodevelopmental Service. Please note that information regarding the Bridgend locality is not included until September 2023, as there was a Service Level Agreement with Swansea Bay University Health Board prior to this, so information was not captured by CTMUHB.

Waiting times have not exceeded 1094 days.
