You asked:

I am writing to submit an FOI request with the following questions:

- Q1. How many total patients has the trust seen within the latest 24 months of available data (for any reason), with a recorded diagnosis of Dravet Syndrome (DS)
- Q2. Of total DS patients, how many have been treated with Epidyolex (Cannabidiol) in the last 12 months?
- Q3. Of total DS patients, how many have been treated with Fintepla (Fenfluramine) in the last 12 months?
- Q4. How many total patients has the trust seen within the latest 24 months of available data (for any reason), with a recorded diagnosis of Lennox-Gastaut Syndrome (LGS)
- Q5. Of total LGS patients, how many have been treated with Epidyolex (Cannabidiol) in the last 12 months?
- Q6. Of total LGS patients, how many have been treated with Fintepla (Fenfluramine) in the last 12 months?
- Q7. How many adult (aged 18+) patients has the trust seen within the latest 24 months of available data (for any reason), with a recorded diagnosis of Dravet Syndrome (DS)
- Q8. How many adult (aged 18+) patients has the trust seen within the latest 24 months of available data (for any reason), with a recorded diagnosis of Lennox-Gastaut Syndrome (LGS)

Our response:

Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board does not hold the information requested.

We only record a definitive diagnosis for inpatient/daycase episodes via the clinical coding process. Therefore, we are unable to confirm the number of patients diagnosed with any disease.
