Please see information provided below. Noting the following:

Question 1 and 2

Admission from A&E do not include any patient admitted to another hospital, they only include patient admitted to a CTMUHB hospitals.

A&E attendances as based on the address at the time of attendance, some NFA patient may be identified using the patient complaint field where NFA has been attached to the complaint.

Question 3 and 4

Includes all hospital admissions within CTMUHB regardless of an A&E attendance and are based on the address at the time of admission.

1. a.) Please provide the total number of A&E attendances by patients of No Fixed Abode/Address.

- Total Number of A&E attendances 2025/2026 so far = 34
- Total Number of A&E attendances 2024/2025 = 112
- Total Number of A&E attendances 2023/2024 = 44
