Freedom of Information Request: Our Reference CTMUHB_377_25

You asked:

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000, can you please provide me with the following information.

1. Can you please tell me how many people held at HMP Parc have been identified as neurodiverse?
2. Can this information be provided for March 2024, June 2024, September 2024 and December 2024.

Our response:

We do not hold this information for all the dates requested. However, we do have information from the snapshot undertaken as part of the Health & Social Care Needs Assessment that was undertaken in 2024. Please see extract below:

At the time of our June 2024 snapshot, a total of 207 prisoners (11.7% of the population) were recorded on SystemOne with any code indicating neurodisability (285 diagnoses recorded in total among these prisoners). With 156 patients recorded with ADHD, 39 patients with ASDs, and 59 patients with learning disabilities, it appears there is some overlap between these groups.
