Thank you for your request for information received on the 18 August 2025, regarding visitor times and parking. Please find the response from Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board set out below:

You asked:

Please can you provide visitor policy information and current visiting times and parking arrangements for visitors across all major hospitals (PCH, RGH & POW).

At the moment my understanding it's individual ward choice in terms of visiting times so when it does differ per ward please make this clear and a rationale why the times differ.

Our response:

Visitor policy information and current visiting times - Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board visiting times vary by hospital ward, but generally, open visiting is between 10am and 8pm for general wards. With Maternity wards having their own specified hours, such as one nominated partner 10 am–8:30 pm and an additional visitor 2pm–4pm. Critical Care visiting times are specific and often require booking, for example, from 12:00–19:00 at Princess of Wales Hospital. Our Paediatric units and Children's wards encourage parents to remain with their child throughout the day and one parent can also stay overnight from 8pm. Siblings and other family members can visit between 1pm and 8pm.

However, to get accurate and up-to-date information, it would be best to contact the specific ward directly around the time of your visit.
