I have a freedom of information request regarding the treatment of melanoma. Could you please answer the following questions:

Q1. How many patients have been treated in the past 3 months with the following agents for melanoma (any stage) :

- Cobimetinib
- Dabrafenib
- Dabrafenib + Trametinib
- Dacarbazine
- Denosumab
- Encorafenib + Binimetinib
- Ipilimumab monotherapy
- Ipilimumab + Nivolumab
- Nivolumab monotherapy
- Nivolumab + Relatlimab
- Pembrolizumab
- Trametinib
- Vemurafenib
- Vemurafenib + Cobimetinib
- Other active systemic anti-cancer therapy
- Palliative care only

Q2. If you do not treat Melanoma patients within your Organisation, which Organisation do you refer your patients to?

Our response:

We can confirm that Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board does not hold the information you require. Cwm Taf Morgannwg residents receive melanoma cancer treatments from the Velindre Cancer Centre or Singleton Hospital (Oncology) based on their postcode. Therefore, you will need to redirect your request to Velindre/Singleton, who provide these services to Cwm Taf Morgannwg residents.
