3.The number of placements in Nursing/Residential Care with costs exceeding £2,500 per week/£130,000 per annum.

The Health Board confirms there are currently 118 placements that exceed over £2,500 per week, excluding income from joint funded placements.

Currently there are 249 total joint funded packages. Out of these the Health Board is the lead commissioner for 113 placement and Local Authority is the lead commissioner for 136 placements.
