You asked:

I am writing to request information under the FOI Act about all your CAMHS services and neurodevelopmental assessment services for Children and Young People.

Please tell me:

- 1. The number of young people on your waiting list for a first appointment (assessment) as of the date of this email or nearest available.**

The number of young people on the CAMHS waiting list for a first appointment (assessment) as of 4th August 2025 is 115.

- 2. The average length of time young people are currently waiting between referral and first appointment (assessment)**

The average length of time young people are currently waiting between referral and first appointment (assessment) for CAMHS as of 4th August 2025 is 4 weeks.

- 3. The average length of time young people are currently waiting between initial referral and first therapeutic intervention.**

The average length of time young people are currently waiting between initial referral and first therapeutic intervention for CAMHS as of 4th August 2025 is 7 weeks.

- 4. How many young people assessed were not offered follow up treatment at CAMHS in the year 2024-25, as a number and a proportion of the total of young people assessed?**

615 young people assessed were not offered follow up treatment at CAMHS in the year 2024-25, which is 39% of the young people assessed.

- 5. The longest time any young person has been on your current waiting list (as of the date of the receipt of this email or nearest)**

The longest time any young person has been on the CAMHS current waiting list as at 4th August 2025 is 4 weeks.

- 6. The average wait between referral and assessment for neurodevelopmental/neurodiverse conditions on the date of this request or nearest available data.**

Within the Neurodiversity Service, the average length of time a child/young person waits for an initial appointment varies between 18-22 months.

7. The number of young people on the waiting list for neurodevelopmental/neurodiverse assessments on the date of this request or nearest available data.

As of 25th July 2025, there are 2868 children/young people on the waiting list for an assessment within the Neurodiversity Service.
