Yes, a compliant direct award was undertaken via the NHS Supply Chain (NHSSC) framework agreement.

#### 4. If the answer to 3 is yes, please provide the following information

##### - When was the tender awarded

The contract commenced 1 November 2024.

##### - Was it awarded to a single supplier, and if so which

Yes, Everlight.

##### - What is the duration of the contract, with optional extension periods

Three years with options to extend for up to a further 2 years.

##### - Was the contract split into lots, for example non urgent routine reporting, and urgent out of hours reporting.

No, the contract was not split into lots.

**5. Which suppliers of radiology reporting services currently have bi-directional access to the authority's patient record systems to allow access to patient records and input of radiology reports.**

Everlight.

**6. Does the risk of cyber attack as a result of providing the access described in 5 appear on the trust risk register and what level of risk rating is it given**

The Health Board carries a risk on the Risk Register in relation to disruption to business continuity due to an adverse cyber event. It doesn't explicitly detail the Radiology Services, however the risk is managed through a number of mitigations including those in place to limit the impact of a connected supplier breach.

**7. Is the trust able to split the spend stated in response to question 1 into: urgent reporting (such as the Medica Nighthawk service for A&E patients); and routine backlog reporting. If so, please provide this split**

**Urgent** – 2025 - £47,640

**Standard** - 2024/25 - £3,214,809 & 2025 - £1,732,459
