## **Freedom of Information/Environmental Information Regulations Request: Our Reference CTMUHB\_156\_26**

Please find the response from Cwm Taf Morgannwg University Health Board on behalf of the NHS Wales Joint Commissioning Committee set out below:

### **You asked:**

Under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, I would like to request information relating to the site selection process for the proposed Wales Air Ambulance base currently under consultation at Rhualt.

Specifically, residents would like to understand the methodology used to identify the proposed site and therefore request the following information:

1. Documentation identifying the original list of approximately 50 potential locations considered.
2. The criteria used to reduce this list to approximately 14 sites.
3. The evaluation process used to identify the final preferred location.
4. Any scoring or comparative assessments used in the decision-making process.
5. Any environmental, planning or landscape assessments undertaken during site selection.
6. Correspondence between agencies involved in the site selection process relating to the suitability of potential locations.

### **Our response:**

We can confirm that the NHS Wales Joint Commissioning Committee (NWJCC) does not hold this specific information.

The JCC undertook geographical modelling in relation to response of the service that assessed 1718 potential locations, all documentation in relation to the work we undertook in relation to the service review is available online via the following link: [EMRTS Service Review - NHS Wales Joint Commissioning Committee](#).
