You asked:

- How many children/families have received a score of 2 or more on the WLOC (Welsh Level of Care) programme (which means they receive additional visits from health visitors? Can I have the figures for the following years 2018/19, 2019/20, 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24, 2024/25, 2025/26 (up to the date of this request)?**

The Welsh Level of Care programme was integrated into the Health Visiting service in 2022. As a result, data relating to WLOC scoring specifically scores of 2 or more was not collected or recorded prior to this point.

Therefore, the Health Board does not hold any WLOC score data for the years 2018/19, 2019/20, 2020/21, or 2021/22.
