You asked:

1. Is the work to repair the roof at the Princess of Wales Hospital now completed? If not, when do you expect to finish?

The work to repair the roof on Phase 1 of the hospital is complete.

2. How much did the repair cost or what is the expected cost of the work once it is complete?

The cost of the work was £11.3m.

3. What functions will remain at the hospital following the completion of this work? I understand that trauma and orthopaedic surgery has been transferred to Royal Glamorgan. Is this correct?

No, as an interim all inpatient elective orthopaedic surgery is based at the Princess of Wales Hospital. With Trauma and day surgery Orthopaedics at Prince Charles Hospital and the Royal Glamorgan Hospital.

4. What other surgery will continue to be carried out at POW?

The Princess of Wales Hospital has 9 non obstetric theatres in total and all are utilised. 3 are ophthalmology, 3 are orthopaedics and the rest are used by all surgical specialities including a dedicated emergency surgery list.

5. Are there any plans to close A&E at the hospital? If not, are there plans to close A&E at either of the other main hospitals within CTM?

No, there are no plans to close A&E at the hospital or either of the other main hospitals within CTM.
